That was the start of an adventure I never dreamed of. I became part of Moms in Prayer. Today over 1400 Moms in Prayer groups pray in our small country, Switzerland, and many more over Europe and the World! I have seen miracles and changes because of the simple fact of mothers united in prayer, in little prayer groups all over Europe and Israel. Prayer is the most effective weapon to change our society and stand against evil influences.

Moms in Prayer International

Moms in Prayer International is a worldwide interdenominational Christian prayer ministry, founded by Fern Nichols in 1984 and led today by Sally Burke. It is made up of mothers, grandmothers, aunts, and women with a heart to pray for children and schools, who meet for one hour a week to pray scripturally for children and schools. By God's grace we impact children and schools worldwide for Christ and our vision is that every school in the world would be covered in prayer.
